

CSIA MASTER CHIMNEY SWEEP® Requirements

Requirements for Application

1. Applicant must be an active CSIA Certified Chimney Sweep® for a minimum of nine continuous years or a minimum total of 18 years (non-continuous) with at least one CEU renewal.
2. Applicant must have completed at least six (6) of the following CSIA courses and or requirements:
 - a. Active certification as a CSIA Certified Dryer Exhaust Technician®
 - b. Chimney Science (additional options):
 - Chimney Physics 2-day in-person
 - Chimney Science Online
 - c. Chimney Documentation to Reduce Liability & Increase Profits (additional options):
 - Inspection & Report Writing 2-day in person.
 - Diagnosis and Documentation
 - d. Advanced Inspection & Documentation
 - e. Masonry 5 Day School (in-person)
 - CSIA Masonry Repair for Chimney Professionals (in-person)
 - CSIA Advanced Masonry repair (in-person)
 - f. CSIA In-Person Reline
 - g. CSIA Rope / Roof Access (in-person)
 - h. NFI Gas, Wood, or Pellet Review
 - i. CSIA MCS EPA BurnWise (online)
 - j. OSHA 10
 - k. CSIA Factory Built Change Out
 - l. 12 hours of CSIA online training (not to include reviews, or chimney science online)
3. Applicant must have an active NFI Certification obtained through the CSIA/NFI Wood, Gas, or Pellet Review and Training class. This requirement may be substituted by an active NFI Certification held for a minimum of six (6) years, a current F.I.R.E Certified Inspector credential, or an Associate level (or higher) degree in Fire Science from an accredited college.
4. A one-time application fee of \$315 paid to the Chimney Safety Institute of America. \$215 of this fee will be refunded if the application is rejected.

Application Process

1. The Master committee will be commissioned and is composed of four persons, including the CSIA Director of Certification and at least one active board member. In the event, an impasse occurs the CSIA Chairman of the Board will cast the deciding vote.
2. Applications should be mailed, along with the application fee of \$315. Check should be made out to Chimney Safety Institute of America and be mailed to the CSIA Technology Center at 2155 Commercial Drive, Plainfield, IN 46168, ATTN: CSIA Director of Certification; or, payment can be made by Visa, Mastercard, or American Express and application and all supporting documents can be emailed to cbenge@csia.org.
3. The CSIA Director of Certification will be responsible for vetting all requirements before submitting qualified applicants to the Master committee for a final decision within 30 days of receiving the application.
4. The Master Sweep committee will render a decision regarding the CSIA Master Chimney Sweep® designation within 30 days of receiving the application from the CSIA Director of Certification.
5. The CSIA Director of Certification will notify applicants by mail of the final decision regarding the Master Chimney Sweep® designation within 60 days of receipt of the application.

Additional Considerations & Retention of Designation

1. Credential can be revoked at any time at the discretion of the Master Committee.
2. CSIA Master Chimney Sweep® must renew with CEUs every 3 years. More information will be received in your packet.
3. A failure to retain any of the certifications required for the Master Chimney Sweep® designation will result in disqualification and notification will be made.
